

Eric Grant Band Headed to National Competition

Gilford's own Eric Grant Band is getting ready to bring their New Hampshire country sound to the national stage in early March. The band is finalizing travel plans to participate in the North America Country Music Association, International competition during its 14th Annual Country Music Week in Pigeon Forge, Tenn., which begins on March 7.

EGB earned a spot in the competition by sweeping the New Country Band of the Year, Vocal Group of the Year, and Male Vocalist of the Year categories in both the New Hampshire Country Music Association and

the regional New England Country Music Organization contests in the fall of last year.

Formed roughly eighteen months ago, the band has quickly gained the attention of fans and critics throughout the region. They have played on countless stages across New England delighting crowds of all sizes. Their performances have included opening support for national acts at Gilford's Meadowbrook U.S. Cellular Pavilion and Massachusetts' Indian Ranch. In November, EGB took to the Main Street Stage and performed for the estimated 20,000 attendees at the

Nashua Stroll.

Said band founder Eric Grant, "Everyone in EGB, from the musicians all the way through our tremendous support staff, has worked very hard to raise our game for each audience we are lucky enough to find. The fans have been great and we're looking forward to carrying the New Hampshire flag to the national stage. There's a lot of great country music going on 'up north' and EGB is going to do its best to leave that mark on the stage in Tennessee."

The band has scheduled a fundraising event for Feb. 25 at Shooters Tavern in Belmont to help offset the costs of the trip to the national competition. There are also a variety of ways to offer support, including a raffle of a personal Eric Grant Band performance, on their web-
